- **Chopper Gun Operator** - Ensure high quality resin application including rolling of resin post application and machinery maintenance
- **Machine Operator** – Manually trim shower bases and walls to specifications including sanding, drilling and leveling bases
- **Woodshop Machine Operator** – Prepare wood bases by cutting wood to desired specifications and assembling wood bases using hand tools.
- **Assembler & Packer** – Install all fittings for tubs and complete final water test. Clean product and perform final quality check to specifications prior to packing for shipment
- **Assembly Operator** - Build sub-assembly and finished goods to requirements for production rates and quality as per work instructions, Work Orders, Bills of Material, and Catalogs
- **Material Handling Operator** – To perform the duties as required throughout the facility in order to receive, move, pick, pack, and ship material in a safe and efficient manner ensuring quality
