Occasionally we delivery to the Peterborough and Kingston areas that may require overnight stays.</p> <p><u>Duties and Responsibilities</u></p> <p>Driver must demonstrate proper daily routines including but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pre-trip inspections, load securement, vehicle cleanliness• Timely and safe delivery of orders over established routes• Secure payment from customers for delivery• Keep accurate records of daily deliveries/transactions• Record and return empty, damaged, or unsatisfactory kegs/bottles/cans to the brewery• Move and lift heavy objects• Operate vehicle in a safe manner, obeying all rules of the road• Report vehicle defects, accidents, traffic violations, or damage to the vehicles.• Communicate effectively with the public, customers, and co-workers both verbally and in written form• Ability to develop customer relationships• Perform periodic inspections before, during, and after delivery to ensure that load is properly fastened down and is secure• Provide feedback to supervisor regarding customer problems, mechanical problems, or delivery problems• Complete all necessary paperwork at the end of the shift.
