- Organize and prepare swimming lessons for a variety of students and effectively and consistently provide instruction and evaluate swimmers according to established standards.
- Preparation, completion and maintenance of required reports, forms, records and statistics.
- Maintenance of the pool area(s) and facilities to ensure safety
