Responsibilities:

- Operate and drive vans and light trucks to deliver cabinetry
- Perform pre-trip inspection of vehicle
- Check all load-related documentation to ensure that it is complete and accurate
- Ensure correct loading of vehicle and that the load is properly fastened down and secure
- Operate vehicle in a safe manner, obeying all rules of the road
- Unload materials at delivery sites and place materials in buildings as directed by Site Supervisor or written directions
- Loading and unloading products in a safe manner, using provided tools as appropriate (e.g. dollies, lifts, etc.)
- Be able to climb stairs while carrying heavy loads
- Comply with all company policies and procedures
- Record information on pick-ups and deliveries, vehicle mileage, fuel costs and any problems encountered
